**O**ne of the most interesting manuscripts currently doing the rounds of the publishing houses is *Looking Beyond The Mirror — True Tales Of Enchanted Wisdom* by Australian author **Tricia Brennan**.

Brennan has recently spent 10 years in Los Angeles, where she helped various celebrities and many of those involved in the film industry understand why their lives are less than fulfilling.
